They will be one day events instead of an entire weekend. Host Chapters will provide classrooms and lunch. The regions, host Chapters, and dates are as follows:

February 11, 2012 Region II (host: RPI)

March 10, 2012 Region III (host: Robert Morris University)

Those who elect to stay overnight either the Friday night before Conclave or the Saturday night after Conclave may make their own sleeping arrangements either with the host Chapter or by making reservations at local hotels. The National Office will provide a list of hotels within the next month.

Each Conclave will focus on the work of Jim Collins; specifically, his book “Good to Great”. Attendees to each Conclave will learn basic concepts of leadership, standard Chapter operating procedures, be able to identify problematic areas in their respective Chapter, be given tools to address the identified problems and motivate others in the Chapter to make changes, understand that change requires simple solutions, and leave with a game plan and strategy to take back to their respective Chapter.
